 - total shareholder return relative to a selected peer group of companies over a period of 3 years from 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2016;
- Unvested Performance Rights lapse on cessation of a holder's employment with the Mermaid Marine Group; and

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• Any Performance Rights that do no vest at the end of the Performance Period (30 June 2016) will lapse.


